



A Checklist for NC IAAI Scholarship

- 1) A panel composed of three (3) members who are selected from the local community by the Scholarship Committee Chairman and who are not members of the NC IAAI, will review the application; judge the essay and make recommendations To The NC Chapter IAAI Scholarship Committee Chairman.
- 2) It is recommended that the selection panel be composed as follows:
 - a) Educators active in their profession including teachers, principals and guidance counselors (2 people)
 - b) Community or civic leaders (1 person)
 - c) Upon Application For Scholarship The Applicant Must:
 - (1) Complete the application.
 - (2) Provide a high school transcript with institution seal.
 - (3) Provide three letters of recommendation
- 3) Applicants will be notified by letter of the selection made and the selection decision is final.
- 4) If possible, the Chapter President will present the scholarship award to the recipient at the recipient's school during recognized award ceremonies.
